INVITATION

The *Colectivo Arqueológico y Paleontológico Salense*, (C.A.S.) and the *Museo de Dinosaurios de Salas de los Infantes* are preparing the celebration of the 8th Symposium about Dinosaur Palaeontology and their Environment, which will be held in Salas de los Infantes (Burgos, Spain) in September 5-7th, 2019. Together with the above-mentioned institutions the University of Zaragoza, the University of the País Vasco/EHU, the University of Salamanca and the University of Vigo will participate in the organization of this symposium.

The main objective of this symposium is the presentation and discussion of recent advances on dinosaur palaeontology, new research technologies and everything related to the Mesozoic ecosystems. To accomplish this objective 8 keynote speakers have been selected among the best Mesozoic palaeontologists. Senior and junior researchers are encouraged to submit an abstract to the 8th Symposium about Dinosaur Palaeontology and their Environment. A half -day post-congress fieldtrip to palaeontological/geological sites in the Salas area will be planned.

On the occasion of the 20th anniversary of this Symposium (1999-2019) two diplomas will be given to the best two presentations of young researchers (younger than 35 years old). One for the best poster and another for the best oral presentation.

LANGUAGE

The official languages of the symposium will be:

- Abstracts: English and Spanish
- Oral presentations: English, Spanish and French.
- Posters: English and Spanish.

The **topics discussed at the Congress** are:

- Footprints, bones and fossil eggs of dinosaurs.
- Mesozoic flora.
- Contemporary dinosaur animals: vertebrates and invertebrates.
- The Mesozoic ecosystems: Their evolution and crisis.
- New technologies applied to the palaeontological research (Mesozoic).
- Conservation and restoration of palaeontological sites and fossil pieces.
- Palaeontological research and educational applications.
- Management and enhancement of the palaeontological heritage related to the environment of dinosaurs.

STANDARDS FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION AND PRESENTATIONS

The abstracts must have a maximum extension of 4 pages and must be submitted in Word format to caspaleontologia@gmail.com. To format the text and the references there is a template available in <http://dinosaurioscyl.blogspot.com>. The text must be written in English or Spanish.

The oral presentations will be done in PowerPoint and will spend 15 min. as maximum including possible questions. We encourage the authors to submit oral presentations in English (optionally oral presentation could be in Spanish). Depending on the number of participants some of the presentations will be posters. The posters size must be 90x120 cm. They will be hanged during the first day and will be removed at the end of the symposium.

The submitted works will be published in an abstracts book, available during the Symposium. Selected papers will be published in a specialized journal, if possible, included in the *Science Citation Index*.
